Register of injury

The Register of Injuries must be kept by the employer in a location where it is readily accessible to workers. Every injury that occurs in the workplace should be recorded, regardless of whether or not a claim is made. Notification of an injury to the insurer must be as soon as practicable.

If details of the injury are entered in the register as soon as possible after the injury happens, the entry is taken to be notice of the injury given to the employer by the injured worker for the Act.
